- **SCHEDULE/ OTHER EVENT REQUIREMENTS:**

Due to the nature of the racing surface no Off Road Vehicles or 4WD vehicles with aggressive tread patterns will be allowed.

- Entries will be accepted in order of receipt unless otherwise specified
- The organisers may refuse any entry in accordance with NCR 33 of the current Motorsport Australia Manual.
- Entries from competitors under 18 years of age must be counter signed / consented to by a parent/guardian.
- Event organisers reserve the right to cancel, abandon or postpone the event in accordance with NCR 11 of the current Motorsport Australia Manual.
- Protests must be lodged in accordance with Part XII of the current Motorsport Australia Manual.

Any holder of a MOTORSPORT AUSTRALIA 'Competition' or 'Officials' licence (or equivalent licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of drugs (or other banned substances) and subject to a penalty(ies) for a breach in accordance with the MOTORSPORT AUSTRALIA Anti-Doping Policy and/or the MOTORSPORT AUSTRALIA Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy as published on the MOTORSPORT AUSTRALIA website. The event will be held on the Mountain View Hillclimb and Kart Circuit. The racing surface is high grip Asphalt and is unsuitable for heavy Off Road vehicles, therefore we are unable to accept entries from any vehicle with a Kerb Weight in excess of 2000kg. e.g., 4WD utes and Toyota Prado/Landcruiser, Mitsubishi Pajero type vehicles. The organiser reserves the right to **reject any entries it considers unsuitable** to the racing surface.
